### 2005-06 Golden Eagle Men's Basketball Outlook

Golden Eagle Men's Basketball returns six players from last year's team. A team that was very competitive throughout the year, but also a team that saw two important players, Antwon Miller and Chad Marks go down with injuries as both players were lost at the Christmas break. UMC was 4-6 at that time, losing very close games to "Red River Rivals" NDSU and UND. In Fargo UMC was up at half but lost to a hot shooting Bison team in the second half. At home against NDSU the score went back and forth all night long with NDSU coming from behind to scratch out another victory. Against UND the Golden Eagles were ahead at the half way point in the second half, but couldn't hold on. UMC also played the number three team in the country Mankato State tough. UMC missed a lay up with 45 seconds to cut the lead to one. Mankato went and made their free throws after that.

It took the Golden Eagles the month of January to get back on track after the Christmas break, but once they did they were a tough team to beat. UMC finished 7th in the NSIC and played Bemidji State in the first round of the NSIC playoffs. This was the first year the Golden Eagles have played in the tournament. They had made it four years ago but were not NCAA eligible at that time.

UMC lost six very important players from last years team in Justin Henry, Ahmid Palmer, Jason O'Polka, Matt Hoie, Jon Smith, and Adam Dombrovski. UMC brought in a very good group of freshmen players, Andy Hughes (6'4) Crookston, Bruce Felts (6'10) Bemidji, Matt Pelzer (6'4) St.Cloud, Bryce Cummings (6'2) Mukawango, WI, Andy Thompson (5'10) Wausau, WI. UMC also brought in three transfers athletes in Josh Foust (6'3) Williston, ND, Maurice Mobley (6'7) El Paso, TX, and Mike Thompson (6'4) Hesperia, CA. Also joining the basketball team is Nick Strobl from Los Angles, CA and Ryan Fisher from Plummer. Returning for UMC is Lee Roberts (6'0, Sr) Pillager, MN, Pat Posl (6'7, Sr) from Bird Island, MN, Mario Bonner (6'8, Jr) Milledgeville, GA, Antwon Miller (6'3, So) Los Angles, CA, Garry Thompson (6'7, Jr) Elk River, MN, Jordan Grafsgaard (6'4, So) Ulen, MN, Musa Kamara (5'10, Jr) Silver Springs, MD.

Coach Oseth had this to say about this year's men's basketball team: We have a good group of players. It seems to me that we have good team chemistry and the work ethic is good. As the year goes on our young players are going to have to mature and give us some quality minutes night in and night out. I expect a solid season from our returners, they have been around and should know what to expect. Traditionally we have been a good rebounding team and we will be tested in that area again this season. In the past we have had one or two guys handle the rebounding load, this year we must rebound well as a team. We are going to have to shoot the ball from the perimeter better this season. We really struggled shooting the outside shot last year. A new player for us this year is Maurice Mobley, we will be counting on him to carry a lot of the scoring load. He is a strong inside presence that can also play on the perimeter. Lee Roberts is back as a four year starter. He plays the point guard spot and any time you have a player that works as hard as Lee and who has played in the number of games Lee has played in you are very fortunate as a coach. If we can stay healthy we will be a competitive team.
