Bryce Cummings had an outstanding weekend for the Golden Eagles, averaging 25.5 points in the weekend's NSIC games against Upper Iowa and #1 Winona State. Cummings was the leading scorer for UMC with 20 points, two steals, and four rebounds, shooting a solid 4-9 behind the three-point line against UIU. Against the defending National Champions, Cummings scored a career high 31 points on 11-18 (61%) shooting. He was 5-10 from long range and a perfect 4-4 from the free-throw line.
